RETREAT AGENDA

The goal of a Kohath Spiritual Renewal Retreat is to bring Christians together in a time of fellowship, communion, Bible Study, worship and spiritual growth. Our theme for this retreat — “Becoming a Person After God’s Own Heart” — will take a deep look into several dimensions of the life of David and challenge us to take those principles into our own lives and hearts.

Day 1: Saturday morning — 7:30 am—9:00 am **Welcome and Introductions**

We will begin our session with a continental breakfast and a fun time of getting to know each other. After this, we will spend some time introducing our theme and setting the stage for our two days together. Finally, we will officially kick off our retreat by joining in praise and prayer together.

Saturday morning — 9:00 am—Noon **PRINCIPLE ONE: Seeing yourself as God and others see you**

David was one of the most unlikely people to ever become King of Israel, yet, God chose him not for his earthly qualifications, but his spiritual ones. We, too, need to see ourselves through God’s eyes if we are ever to fulfill His purpose. Saturday morning’s session will look at this first principle in the life of David and in our own lives as well.

Saturday afternoon — 1:00 pm—4:00 pm **PRINCIPLE TWO: The Right Stones for Giants**

One of the most famous stories in the Bible is the story of David and Goliath the Giant. In spite of great adversity, David defeated his enemy with three stones and the power of God on his side. The giants we face every day in our own lives can be intimidating, but this principle will help us understand the keys to winning our own battles.

Saturday evening — 6:00 pm—9:00 pm **PRINCIPLE THREE: I Don’t Feel Anointed**

In times of trial or distress, God can feel very far away and trusting in His plan can be difficult. In many times of conflict, David called out to God through Psalms. Yet, in spite of trial, David held on to the promises of God and saw His plan revealed in his life. This principle will discuss how we can learn to trust God in the difficult points of our lives.

Day 2: Sunday morning — 9:00 am—Noon **PRINCIPLE FOUR: Living Out Your Calling**

Each of us has been uniquely created by God and are called to serve in His kingdom. Only by understanding and accepting our calling can we truly live a full and abundant life in Christ. David’s calling to be King of Israel happened many years before it was actually fulfilled. Looking at his life, we will seek to dedicate our own to seeking God’s will and growing in Him.

LOGISTICS & DIRECTIONS

- The Heritage Inn & Golf Club is located at 2 Postal Lane, Rehoboth, Delaware.
- From Philadelphia & Wilmington: Take I-95 South to Delaware Route 1 South (by the Christiana Mall). Follow Route 1 South towards the beaches. The Heritage Inn is two miles south of Five Points on the right.
- From Baltimore & Washington D.C: Cross the Chesapeake Bay Bridge (US Route 50) eastbound near Annapolis. Follow Route 50 East. Turn left onto Maryland Route 404. Follow Route 404 through Denton to the Bridgeville, DE by-pass. Follow signs to the Delaware Beaches. On the southeast side of Bridgeville, turn left onto US Route 9. Continue on Route 9 East through Georgetown, DE. Turn right onto Highway One towards Rehoboth. The Inn is about two miles south on the right.
